



Discover Heroic Viticulture in Madeira

Join us for a guided tour through a traditional family-run vineyard nestled in the breathtaking landscape of Seixal, on Madeira's dramatic north coast. Learn about the heroic vine-growing practices that make Madeira wine so unique—on steep terraces (poios), under trellises (latadas), and with hard manual labour passed down through generations.

As you walk through our vineyard, you'll hear the stories of a family that lives the wine tradition, admire the lush Laurissilva forest, and enjoy views of the iconic Vêu da Noiva waterfall. The tour ends with a tasting of a fine 10-year-old Sercial Madeira wine made from our grapes, paired with some delicious local cheese—plus a little surprise!

This is more than a wine tour—it's a cultural journey supporting the preservation of Madeira's viticultural heritage.

VÊU DA NOIVA VINEYARD TOUR

Duration: 75—90 min

Location: Seixal, North Coast of Madeira

GPS: 32°48'58.63"N 17° 5'47.28"W

Itinerary: From Funchal, take the VR1 highway west toward São Vicente. After passing through São Vicente, continue on the ER101 coastal road in the direction of Seixal. Shortly before reaching Seixal, you'll find the Vêu da Noiva viewpoint. The vineyard is located nearby—look for parking near the waterfall. The drive takes around 45 to 60 minutes.

Moderate walk; wear comfortable shoes
