The Centre for Activities and Capacity Building for Inclusion (CACI) of Santa Cruz, integrated within the Institute of Social Security of Madeira (ISSM, IP-RAM), has the mission of promoting the functional, social, and overall development of persons with disabilities, with a focus on inclusion, rehabilitation, and active participation in the community.

In this context, the ISSM, IP-RAM, through the CACI of Santa Cruz, expresses its support and consent for the candidacy of the Madeira Wine Traditions to the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity, recognising in this practice an identity symbol of the Autonomous Region of Madeira.

As an institution that promotes inclusion through culture, the CACI considers this nomination an opportunity to strengthen the sense of belonging and appreciation of regional heritage, including among its participants.

For these reasons, the ISSM, IP-RAM, through the CACI of Santa Cruz, expresses its unconditional support for the nomination of the Madeira Wine Traditions. We reaffirm our commitment to active collaboration in their promotion and safeguarding, recognizing this heritage as a vital, living expression of Madeiran culture and identity. We are fully dedicated to ensuring that these traditions continue to enrich and unite our community for generations to come.
